



## If your pet goes missing

Telephone Ealing Council's stray dogs service

Call a local animal rescue centre; they keep lost-and-found databases

Check with local vets in case anyone has handed in your pet

Put up posters with a photo and details of your pet as well as your own contact details. Also put copies through neighbours' doors.

Ask neighbours if you can look in their sheds or garages yourself (your pet may not respond to a stranger)

Contact <u>Animal Search UK</u>, which has more than 20,000 volunteers patrolling for missing pets

Think about having a microchip inserted or make sure your pet has a collar and tag with your name and contact details
