- MHPRA policy on commenting on planning applications published
- 20 planning applications reviewed
- Comments on ten applications submitted, including seven objections
- Successfully objected to five applications; decision on one still pending
- MHPRA comments cited in Planning Officers' decision reports
- Meeting with Educational Funding Agency to discuss redevelopment of Acton College site



# *Environment*

---

- Instances of fly-tipping regularly reported
- Ward funding secured to produce information leaflet on fly-tipping
- Vandalised trees on Gunnersbury Lane replaced
- Progress made with registration of Mill Hill Gardens with London Parks & Gardens Trust
- Two planting and maintenance sessions at Crown Street Pocket Garden
- MHPRA participation in Great British Spring Clean to tidy up Mill Hill Park and neighbouring streets
- 17 applications to lop or fell trees in Mill Hill Park reviewed
- Basal tree growth in Heathfield Road, Avenue Crescent and Avenue Gardens cut back
